EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education has adopted the following criteria for the naming of institutions:

- 1. The applicant institution must possess substantially all of the characteristics of a two-year higher education institution.
- 2. The applicant institution must be accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.
- 3. The area commission of the institution must take prior formal action to approve the submission of an application to the State Board in accordance with the procedures prescribed.
- 4. The name shall be <u>(descriptor of Service Area)</u> Technical College.
