The State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education shall require that all technical colleges entering into partnerships with high schools or secondary vocational centers which result in the award of college credit, such as technical and dual enrollment programs, must ensure that the credit awarded is at the postsecondary level and meets all requirements of SBTCE policies and procedures as well as all requirements of the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. The colleges granting the academic credit must assume full responsibility for the academic quality and integrity of such partnerships.
