- 8. Develops and coordinates informational media on the programs, divisions, and services of the Technical Education System.
- 9. Provides the leadership for the direction and establishment of all short- and long-range plans for the System.

Serves as the official point of contact with the Governor's Office, Attorney General's Office, General Assembly, State Development Board, Commission on Higher Education, Coordinating Council for Economic Development, Commission on Aging, Department of Social Services, Department of Education, and all other appropriate State, Federal, and private agencies.
- 11. Performs other duties and/or responsibilities assigned or delegated by the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education.
