If a student is enrolled in a curriculum and terminates the enrollment without earning the completion award, and if that curriculum is subsequently cancelled, and if at a later date the student seeks to complete the course of study and earn the award, then the following consideration must be met. A student who has completed the curriculum requirements and who applies for graduation after the curriculum has been cancelled must follow the same procedure.

The student must petition the college to complete the course of study and earn the award. The college must determine if the award is warranted. If the college finds merit in the student's petition, the college will request approval from the System President to allow the student to complete the original course of study and earn the original award.
