TECHNICAL EDUCATION REPORTING DEADLINES

Colleges must submit their technical education data records according to the following reporting deadlines:

Ending Summer /Opening Fall	- October 15
Ending Fall /Opening Spring	- March 15
Ending Spring Opening Summer	- July 31
Completions (Graduates)	- September 15
Faculty	- December 1

Colleges are responsible for insuring that technical education (TE) data are free of EDSS errors, verified for accuracy by college staff, and submitted by these dates. The SCTCS and The Commission on Higher Education (CHE) have a two week window after the due dates for further state level validations. In the event CHE identifies errors in a college's data, the college will be notified to correct these errors and resubmit the data. Reminder notifications will be emailed out to the Chief Business Officers' peer group and other key personnel prior to each deadline.

PROCEDURE

The Student Enrollment Data consists of four data and record types (EE, ET, ES, and EA). The ES and EA records are specific to The Technical College System and are not transmitted to CHE. The complete definitions and Files Layouts are found at:

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The Disbursement Data consists of six seven data and record types (ED, EN, ET, EE, EX, EF, & EJ). Students reported in this file are receiving state or federal financial assistance. The EX record is specific to The Technical College System and is not transmitted to CHE. Reminder notifications will be emailed out to the Chief Business Officers' peer group and other key personnel prior to each deadline.

PROCEDURE
